Welcome and Compassion

- A space committed to compassion and accessibility that is more natural than an accommodation, including gender-neutral bathrooms and easy wayfinding for a diversity of mobility and sensory needs. This includes spaces that are connected, inviting, and inspirational.

Community and Spiritual Growth

- A space that is intended for use beyond ourselves. This includes spaces that are easily utilized by the wider community as a catalyst for conversation, learning, service and the arts. This includes flexible space to nurture spiritual growth through rites of passage, fellowship, and community service.

Practicing Justice

A space that is deeply connected with the natural world. This includes an
eco-justice focus with sustainable utilities and land stewardship, connection
to nature with windows and natural light, and outdoor green space for
learning, spiritual practice, communal gardening, social events, and play!
